This is also a good time to visit any campus offices that you need to. Offices are open Monday through Thursday 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Friday hours vary.

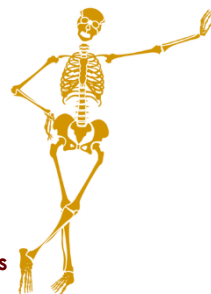
