I see in under III. SCOPE OF WORK/SPECIFICATIONS Section 2. SERVICE SCHEDULE, "2.1. Prior to commencement of work, Contractor shall submit for review a schedule for performing the required periodic services of the contract. This schedule shall be coordinated with Facilities Management to meet service needs and may be changed as directed by Facilities Management to minimize conflicts. The "Exterminator Schedule" is attached to this solicitation." Will that current "Exterminator Schedule" be followed as set forth in the IFB or can it be altered with the Facilities Management review & approval
