This motion was approved unanimously. The motion regarding the Accelerated Programs and Transfer Policies Revision passed unanimously.

- MBA-BADM-SPRG: NEW, MBA - Sports Revenue Generation, niche MBA offering that builds on the existing MBA core.
- MEd-LTEC: Learning Technologies - moving the concentration in Educational Technology within the MED C&I program to a freestanding degree program. Program is 100% online.
