• **#2 - NAMECOACH**:

 To help ensure that every graduate's name is pronounced correctly, an e-mail will be sent by NAMECOACH requesting for degree candidates to upload a recording on pronouncing their name.





- THERE MUST BE NO PENDING ISSUES -


All coursework and other degree requirements <u>MUST</u> be completed:

- ✓ All coursework must be completed and passed
- ✓ Cumulative GPA
- Total hours toward degree
- ✓ Hours above 599
- Any incomplete grades must be resolved
- ✓ Thesis, Oral Comps, and/or Recitals must be completed.

CLEARING FOR GRADUATION

- HOW WILL I KNOW WHEN I HAVE GRADUATED? -

Once all final grades have been reported and students are successfully cleared for graduation, their graduation status will be checked off on Degree Works.



We will notify students immediately if there are any issues clearing them for graduation (e.g., incomplete coursework or unmet degree requirements).

DIPLOMA PICK-UP

- December 2020 Graduates will have the opportunity to come to campus and pick up their diplomas on Saturday, December 19, 2020. Masks are required for all participants.
- You will receive an **email** that will provide **time & location** to pick up your diploma.
- You may wear your CAP & GOWN the day of Diploma Pick-Up.
- LIFETOUCH PHOTOGRAPHY will be on campus to take your photo.

IF YOU HAVE AN ACCOUNT BALANCE - NO DIPLOMA -

If you have a balance, you will receive e-mails (labeled 'YOU HAVE A BALANCE') (started in LATE OCTOBER) alerting you of the balance owed on your account.

Be sure to keep an eye on your account! Last-minute charges can be added to your account for things such as traffic tickets, printing charges, etc., so be sure to check your account frequently in November and beginning of December.

December 4th = last day for e-checks and personal checks

December 11th = last day for Debit/Credit payments

IF YOU HAVE AN ACCOUNT BALANCE - NO DIPLOMA -

IF YOU HAVE A REMAINING BALANCE AFTER December 11th... a diploma hold will be placed on your account. Your diploma and transcripts will be held until all balances are paid in full and your payment clears the bank.

IF YOU PAY YOUR BALANCE AFTER December 11th... pay only in cleared funds (debit/credit card, cashier's check from your bank, money order, or cash).

DO NOT PAY BY CHECK AFTER December 11th... as Student Financial Services is required to hold your diploma and transcripts until the check clears our bank. This might not be until AFTER graduation!

TIME FOR SOME Q&A

1. Question: Will the virtual graduation be able to be viewed after December 19th and will it be shareable so that family members can view it?

Answer: Yes, it will be posted on YouTube and remain available for several months.

2. Question: What do we need to do/bring to prepare for the DIPLOMA PICK-UP event?

Answer: Please be sure to have your Student ID with you. If you do not have an official WU ID, a driver's license will work just fine.

3. Question: What is the schedule for the virtual commencement ceremony event? For example, schedule of speakers and when degree recipients' names will be called.

Answer: Graduates will receive detailed information on the virtual commencement ceremony in the coming weeks. The ceremony will be pre-recorded and include a welcome and remarks by Interim President Hynd, conferring of the degrees, a welcome from the Alumni Association, and most importantly a picture and/or short video from each graduate. Graduates will receive an email asking you to upload content (picture and/or video) from StageClip and a second email from NameCoach asking you to record the pronunciation of your name. Students must log-in to StageClip and verify your intent to participate in the virtual ceremony.

4. Question: If I opted out of the commencement ceremony when I applied, am I still able to come and pick up my diploma?

Answer: Absolutely.

5. Question: Can family come to pick up diplomas?

Answer: PLEASE NOTE that final details are still being worked out.

If the DIPLOMA PICK-UP is drive by only then yes, the graduate may have others in the car with them. However, if at the DIPLOMA PICK-UP graduates must park and come get their diplomas, we ask that the family remain in the car and not be with the student while they're picking up the diploma. This will help with safety and timing.

6. Question: Should graduates to wear masks when they pick up their diplomas?

Answer: Yes, masks are absolutely needed. Masks are mandatory except when having your picture taken.

7. Question: Is a cap and gown required to be worn at Diploma Pick-Up?

Answer: No, cap and gowns are not required to be worn the day of Diploma Pick-Up. Should you want your photo taken in your hood, there will be assistance available to properly adjust the hood.

8. Question: Can I wear a borrowed cap and gown to Diploma Pick-up Day?

Answer: Yes! Students are welcome to wear borrowed **black** caps and downs to Diploma Pick-Up Day. Tassels and hoods can be purchased separately from the Winthrop Bookstore.

9. Question: If my name is in the commencement program and is announced at the virtual commencement ceremony does this mean I graduated?

Answer: No, not necessarily. Because degree candidate names are submitted prior to graduation for printing purposes and pre-recorded for virtual commencement purposes it will not reflect your official graduation status. This information will be found in Degree Works or your official records. Please be sure to check this before coming to the Diploma Pick-Up event.
