

## Sharing a TechSmith Video Link in Blackboard

---

### Overview

This tutorial will explain how to obtain a share link for a Techsmith video and how to post the share link in Blackboard. The share link can be posted in any text editor box, including Discussion Threads and Assignments.

### Step 1

Log into [Techsmith Relay/Knowmia](#). From your TechSmith library, select the video you want to share. When the video page opens, click the Share button below the video.



### Step 2

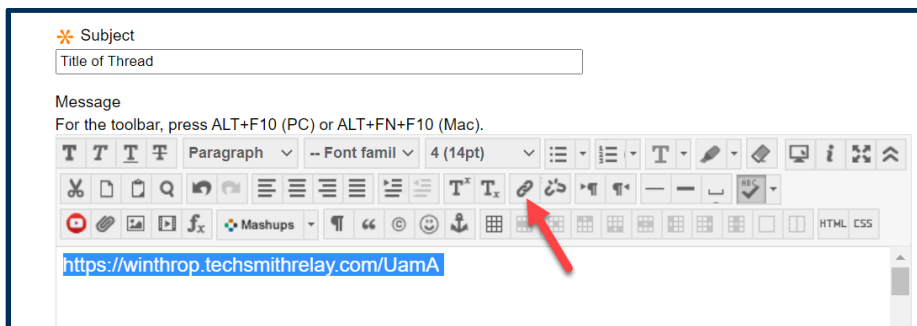
Select Get a Link, then copy the Link URL that appears in the pop-up window.

### Step 3

Log into Blackboard and open your course. Go to the location where you want to share the link. You can post the link anywhere you have access to a text editor box, including Discussion Threads and Assignments.


### Step 4

In the Text Editor, paste the URL that you previous copied. You can use CTRL+V to paste. Highlight the URL, then click the Insert/Edit Link button (looks like chain links).



## Step 5


In the pop-up window, paste the same URL in the Link Path text area. In the drop-down menu for Target, select Open in New Window. Add a title that describes the video. Then click Insert at the bottom.

## Step 6

You will return to the page with the text editor box. You should now see the link in the text editor box underlined to show that it is an active link. Add any additional text you need in the text box, then click Submit to post the entry.
