This year, the allocations committee began with 29,000. The year started quickly and I was excited to see that over 20 organizations attended the first training meeting! This year the committee reviewed 57 requests; the committee decided as a whole to fund 24 travel requests, 27 on campus events and 11 operational costs. The total amount requested was \$47,099.63.

Through the Council of Student Leaders and various on campus organizations, we worked hard to let the campus know what SAC was and how we are here to help the student body! 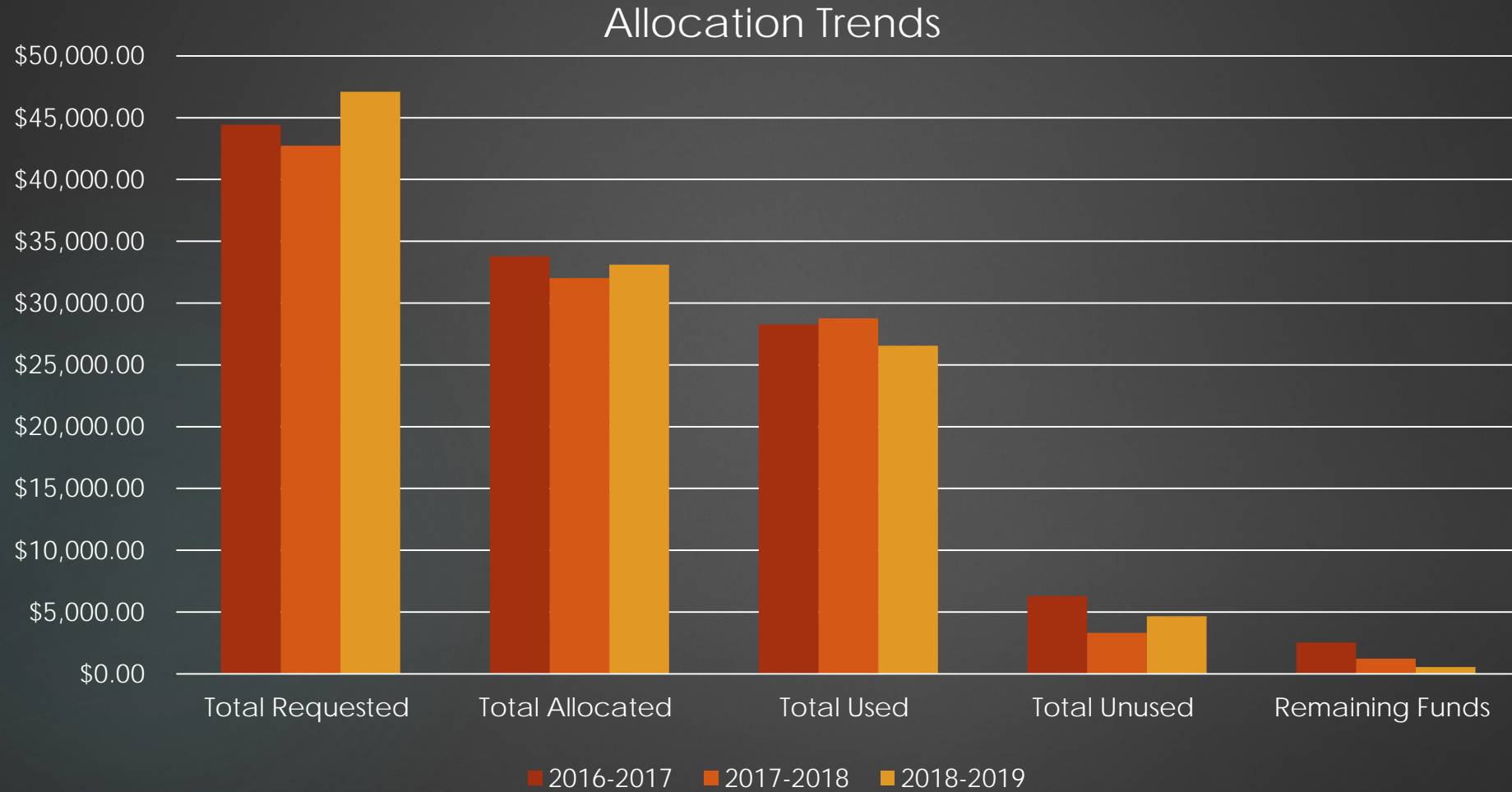
