












#### **Spending Analysis**













# University Advancement FY20 Annual Work Plan

- Goal 1: Deliver a safer, more secure, and more enjoyable tailgating experience to all 2019 Homecoming participants.
- Goal 2: Support the volunteer alumni leadership and programming for our regional and national alumni chapters. At this time, we support nine (9) alumni chapters and five (5) young alumni or graduates of the last decade (GOLD) chapters.
- Goal 3: Meet or exceed goal of 110 cumulative Winthrop Leadership Society (WLS) memberships by December 31, 2019 (CY 2019).
- Goal 4: Frontline Development Officers to secure an additional \$100,000 in Winthrop Fund gifts and pledges through WLS memberships for calendar year 2020.



# University Advancement FY20 Annual Work Plan (cont.)

- Goal 5: Continued implementation of Enterprise Data Quality (EDQ) initiatives to improve alumni connectivity with their alma mater and improve effectiveness of UA programming and initiatives.
- Goal 6: Meet or exceed \$350,000 cash goal established by the Foundation Board for calendar year 2019.
- Goal 7: Establish, rollout, and market unrestricted Winthrop Endowment for future gifts.
- Goal 8: Meet or exceed goal of 690 personal development visits for calendar year 2019.
- Goal 9: Raise at least \$4,000,000 in gifts and pledges in support of Winthrop University.
