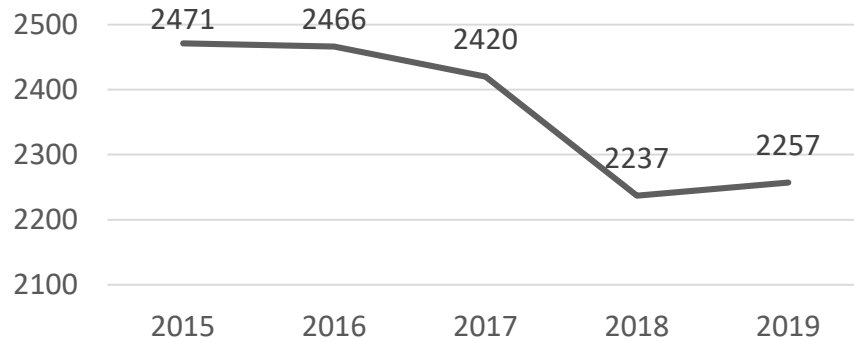

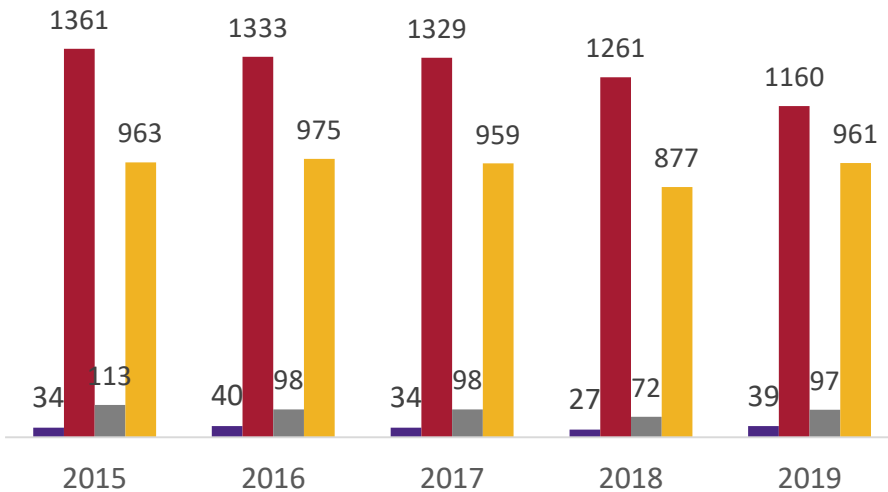

Total Housing Occupancy Numbers

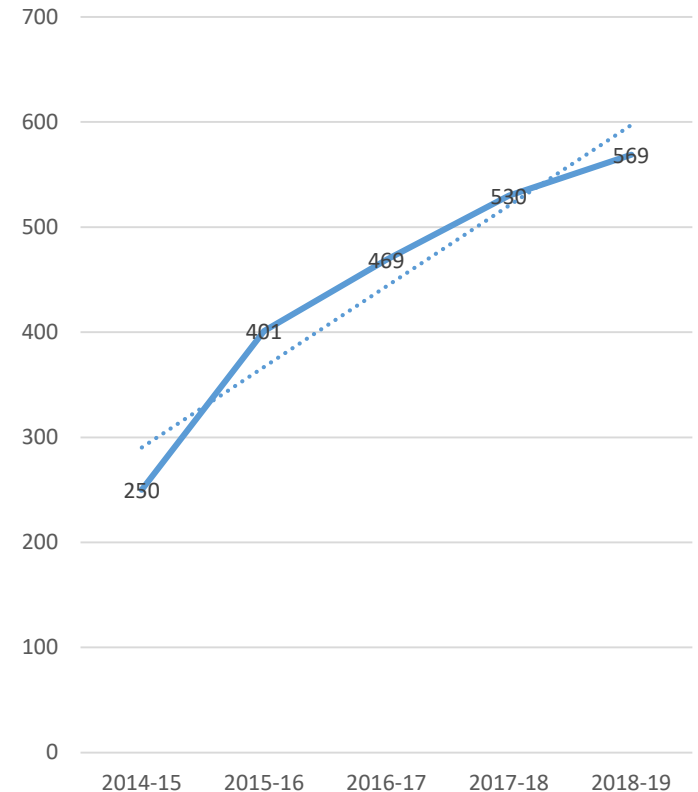


Occupancy By Student Type

Other Continuing Transfer Freshmen (First Time)

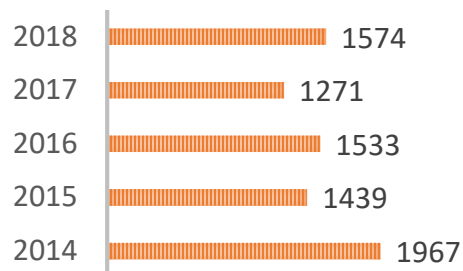


Number of Students Connected with Accommodations

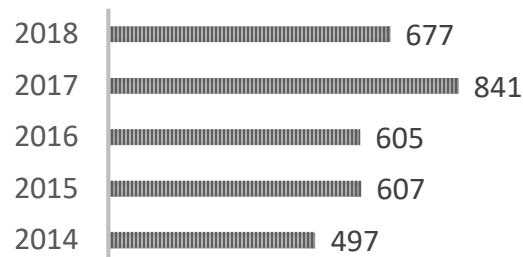

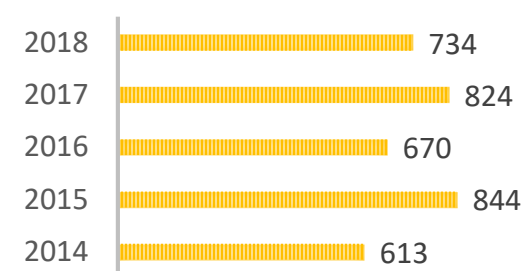

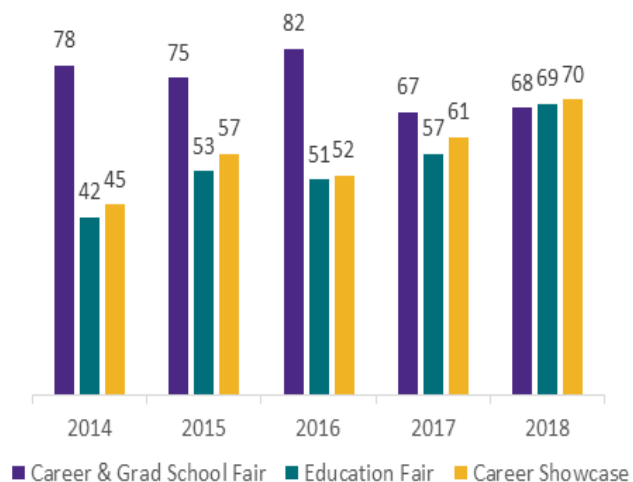
Student Participation: Career Fairs



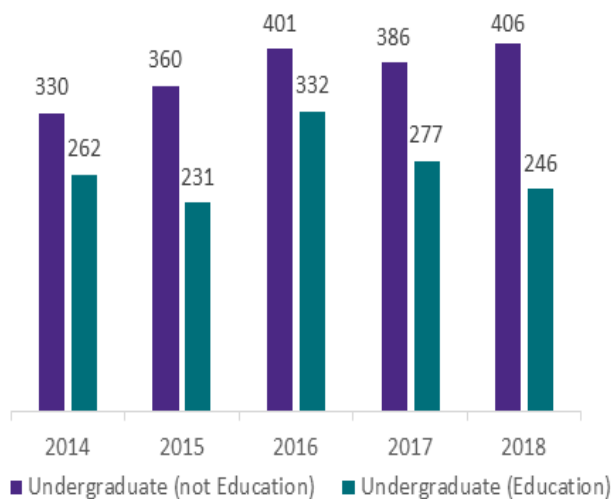
Student Participation: Career Appointments



Employer Participation in Career Fairs

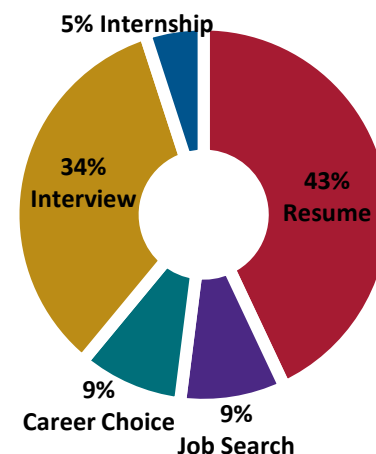


Student participation in Internships



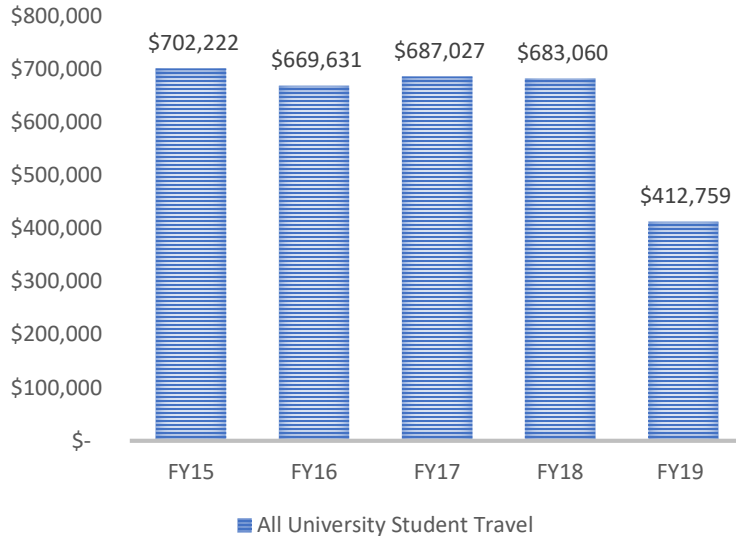

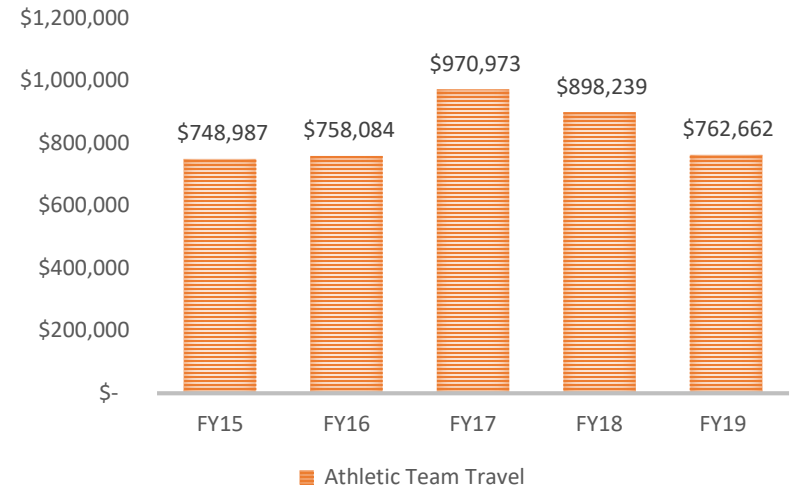

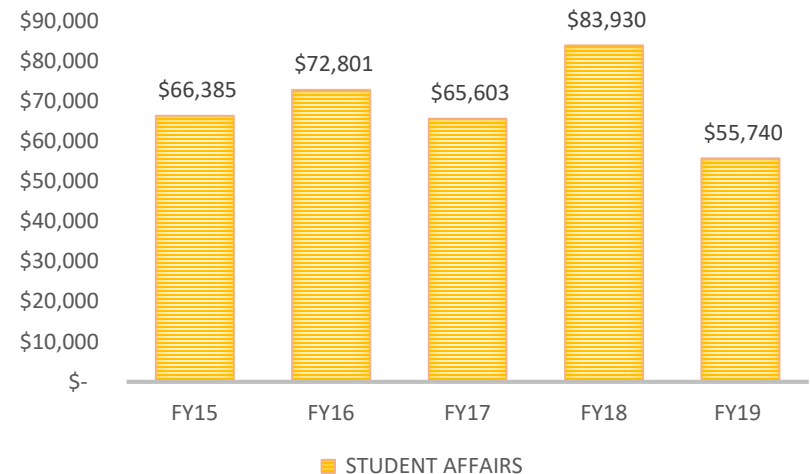


Athletic Team Travel



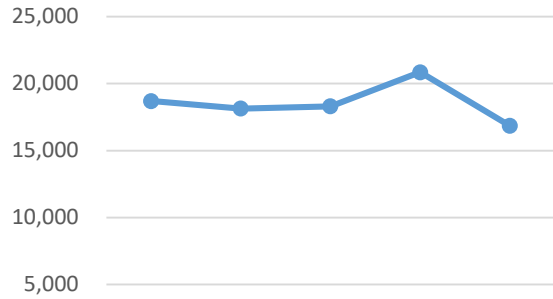

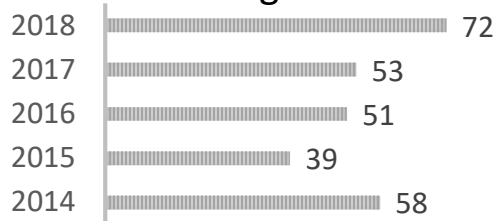

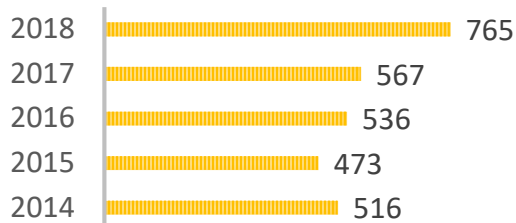

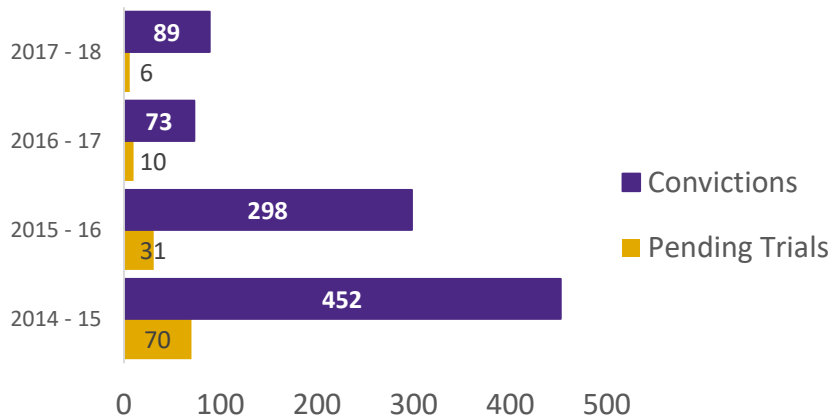
COURT CASES - TYPE



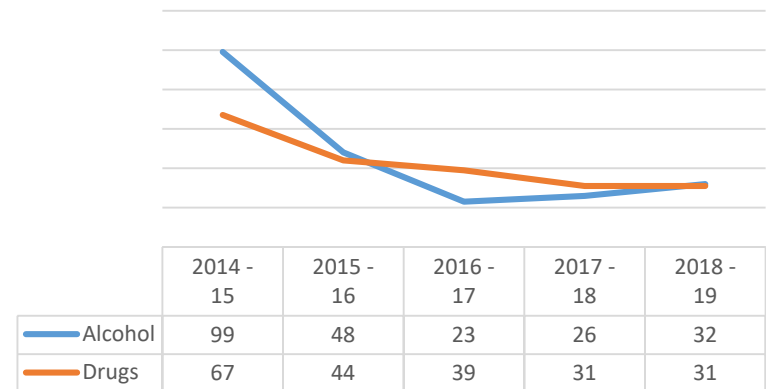

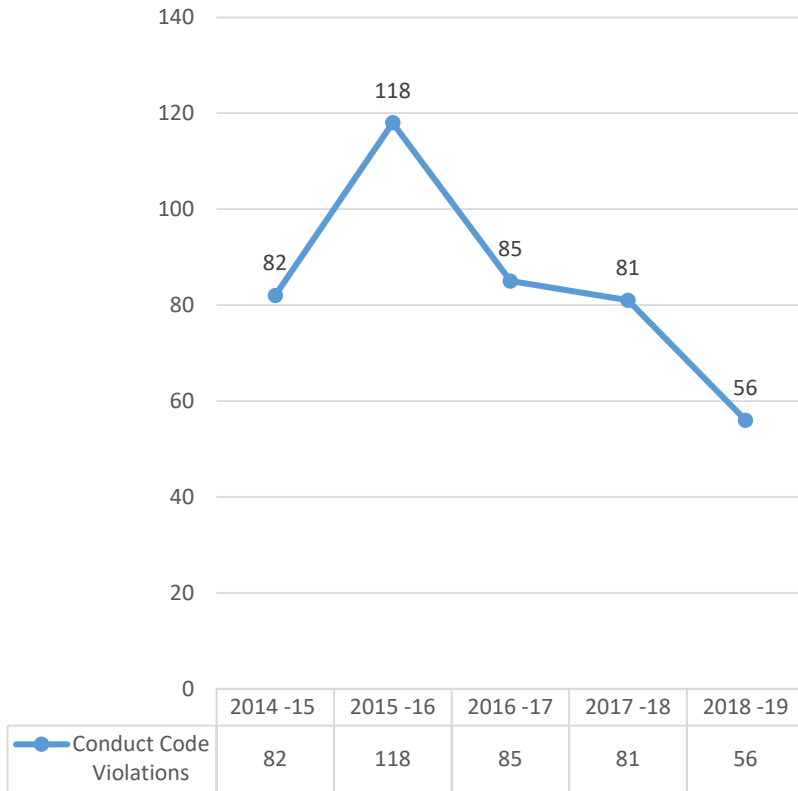


DRUG AND ALCOHOL RELATED INCIDENTS



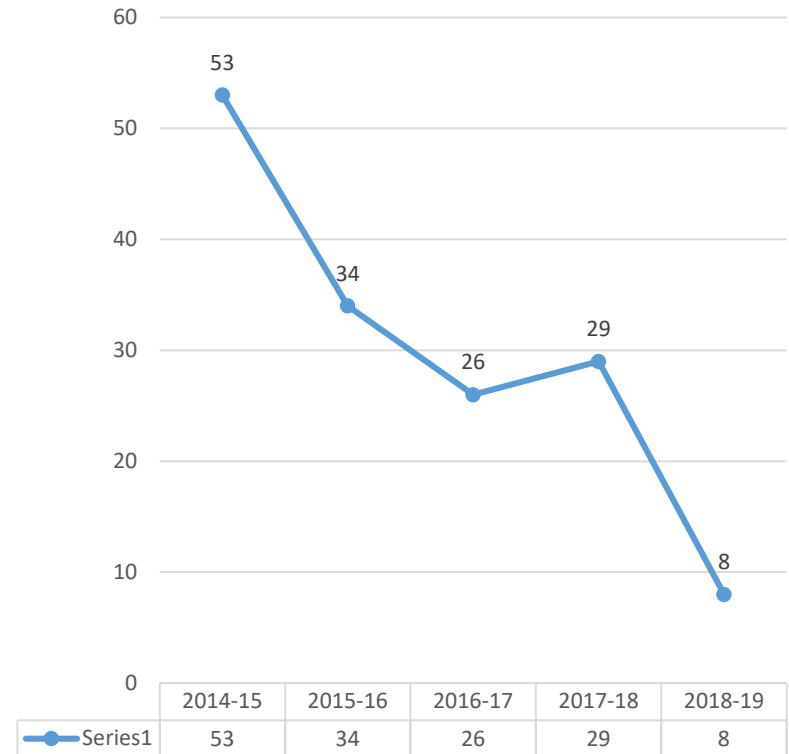

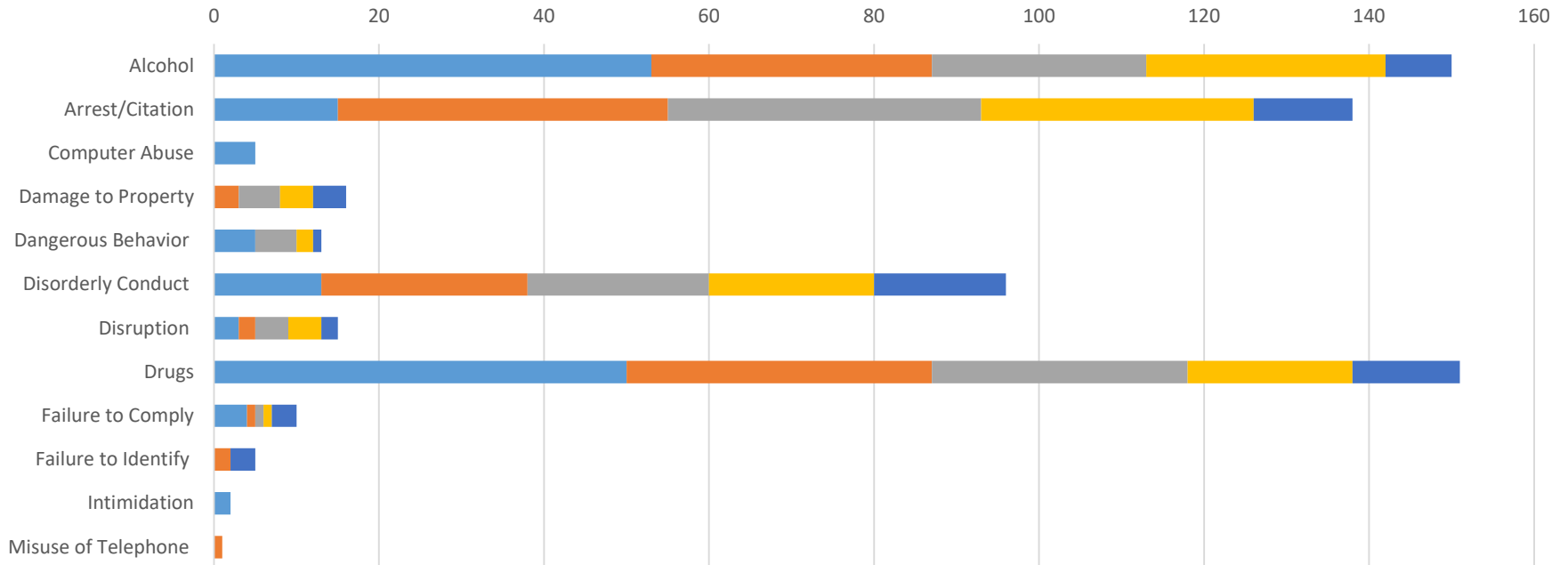
Total Academic Misconduct Cases

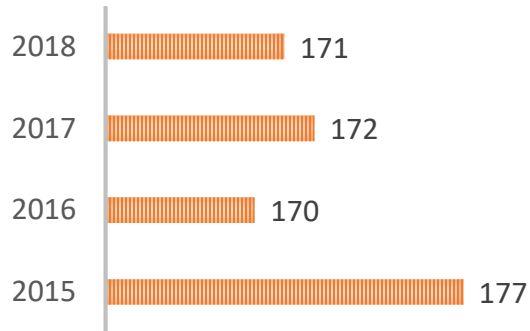

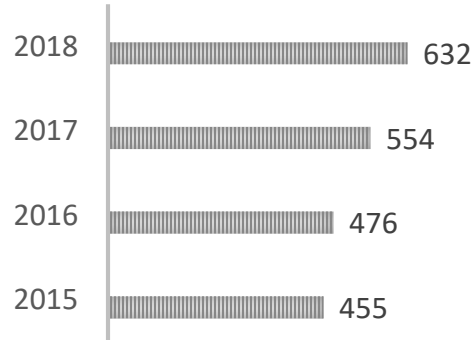

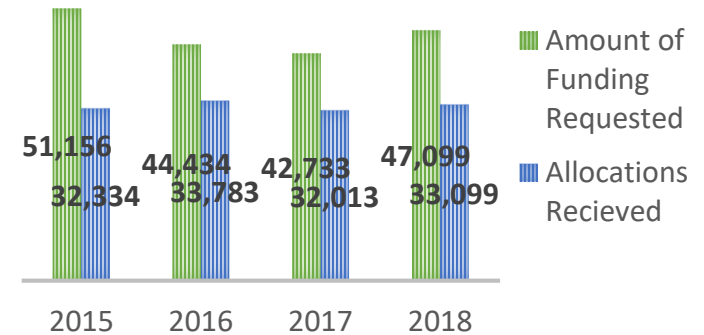
Number of Student Organizations



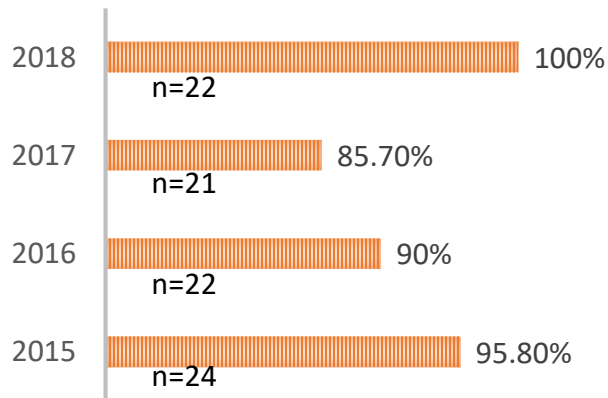
Number of Student Leaders



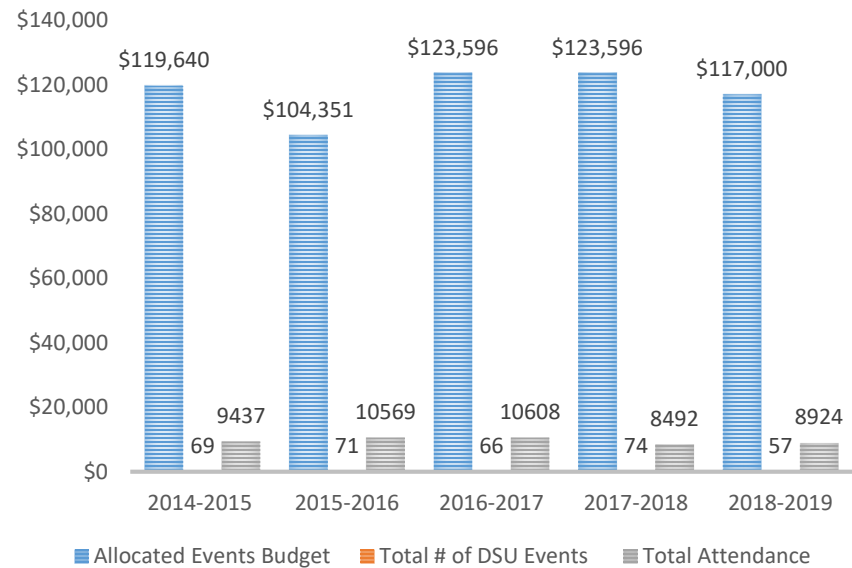
Student Organization Allocations



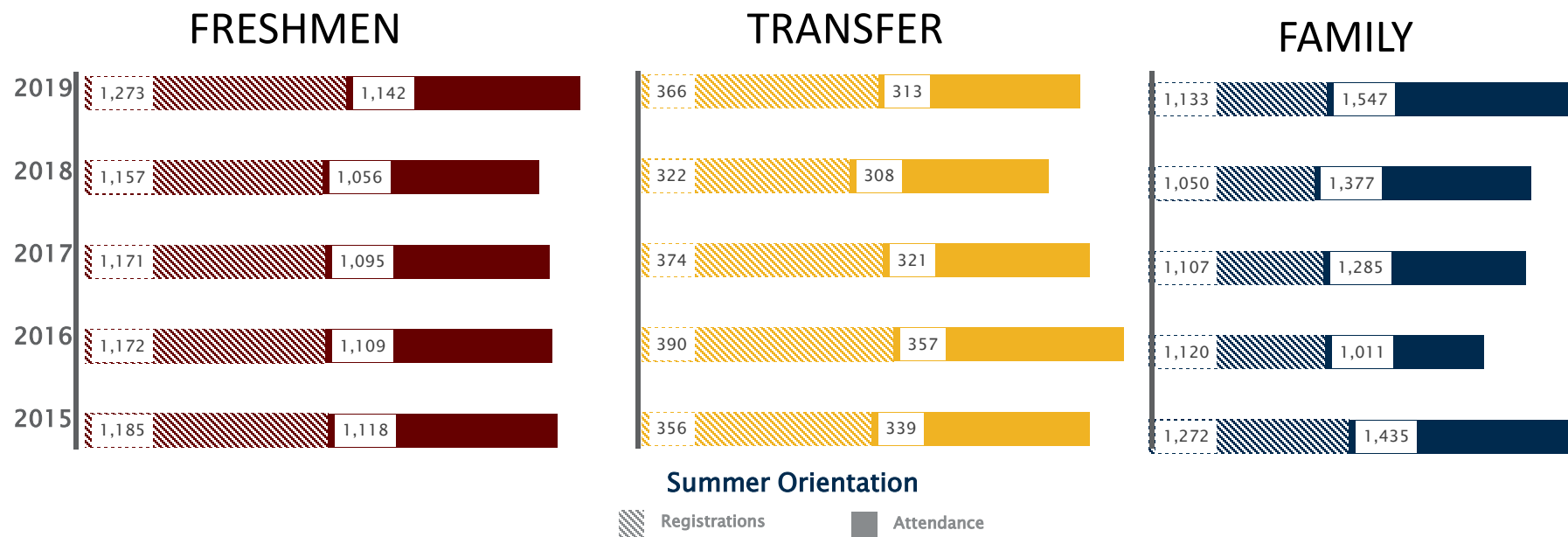
Emerging Leader Retention (Fall to Spring of First Year)



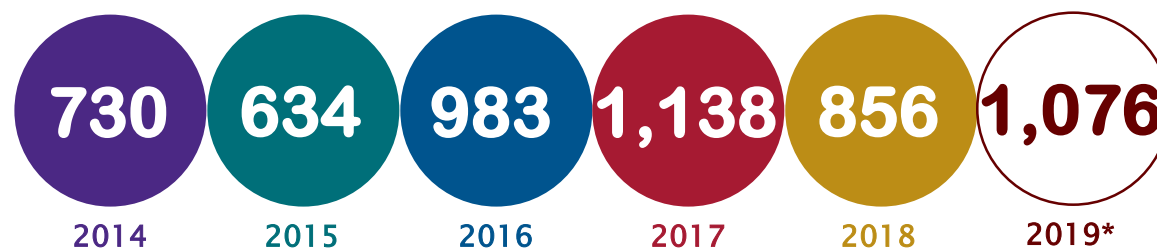

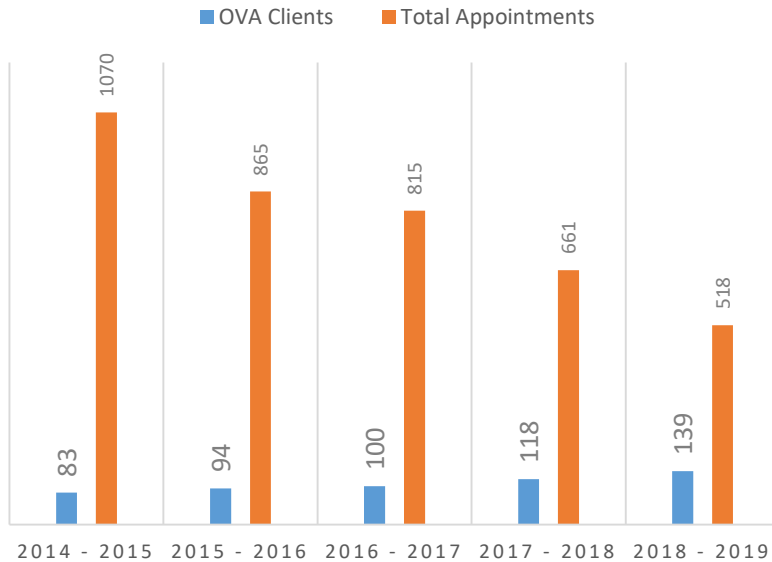
FAMILY DAY ATTENDANCE



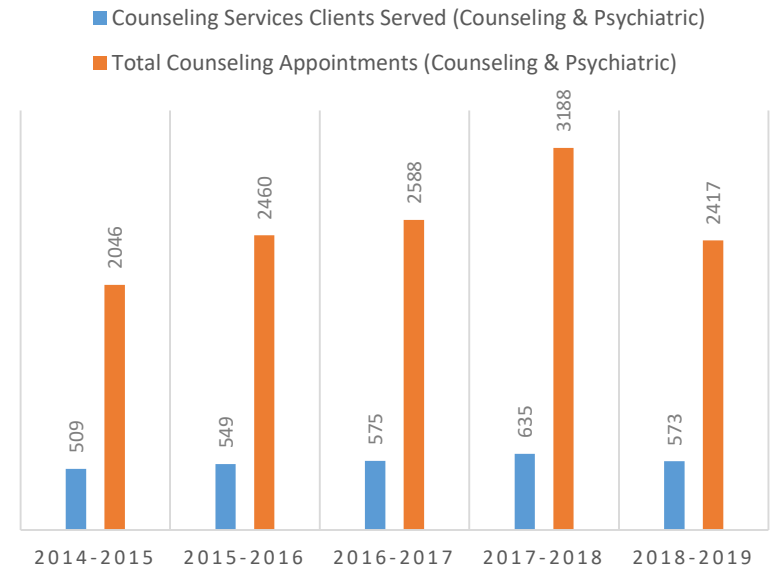
Family Day 2019 occurred October 5. The number of registrants was significantly higher than last year, and on par with 2017.

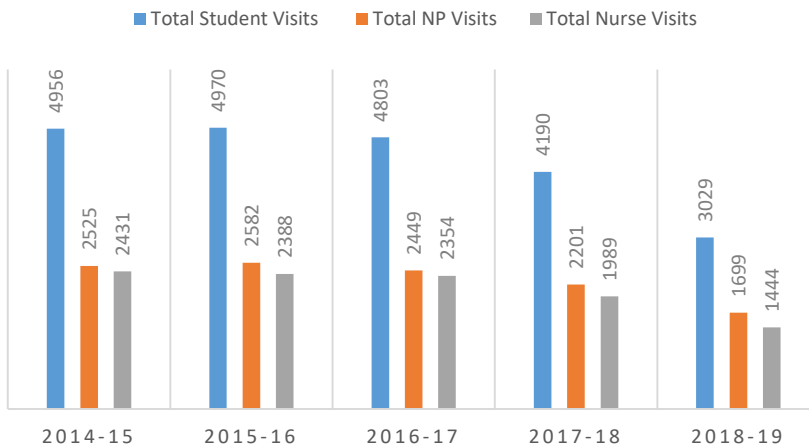
Office of Victim's Assistance Clients And Appointments By Year
