




Total Housing Occupancy Numbers









Employer Participation in Career Fairs








- Student Affairs Student Travel represents approximately 11% of the All University Student Travel Budget, and is reflected in the total.


COURT CASES - TYPE




DRUG AND ALCOHOL RELATED INCIDENTS






Code Violation By Item









Emerging Leader Retention (Fall to Spring of First Year)


FAMILY DAY ATTENDANCE




Family Day 2019 occurred October 5. Thr number of registrants was significantly higher than last year, and on par with 2017.


